ACCOMMODATION

If you have not yet found accommodation when you arrive, if your room is not yet available, or if your friends or family want to visit you. Think of the hostels that are ready to help you out if you need it.

Airbnb is the first application to check out, but it's not always the best solution compared to youth hotel and cheap accommodations. Here are some you may like:

TIPS & TRICKS

Visiting an apartment does not commit you to anything, it's free!

No payment should be made by money order or by cash, it's risky and could lead you to scams.

Here are some important points you should check in your contract lease :

Start date and duration Type of use (private, business or both), rental price, terms of payment and price revision terms.

It must be signed by both the landlord and each tenant, and everyone must get a copy.

Clear Terms of cancellation (You can leave a flat on a month notice via letter).

Charges, and taxes that the tenant must pay

The amount of the deposit.



We have chosen three of the many student residences that are worth giving a try, they are well balanced between pricing, location & the quality of the flat:



We recommend you to book an accommodation in the following districts:

1st district : Terreaux - Croix Rousse - Chartreux / **2nd district :** Bellecour - Perrache - Confluence - Cordeliers / **3rd district :** Part Dieu - Villette - Dauphiné - Mon Chat / **7th district :** Gerland - La Mouche - Jean Macé - Guillotière Sud / **8th district :** Montplaisir - Bachut - Mermoz - États-Unis / **6th district :** Brotteaux - Tête d'Or - Bellecombe

MORE TIPS & TRICKS

A precise inventory of the situation is important. Before signing the lease, pay attention to the compulsory inventory of fixtures on entry. This one must be very precise! Do not hesitate to insist on marking everything. For example, if a piece of furniture is declared to be in good condition but is in a damaged state, you may be charged for repairing it when you leave. Test all electrical outlets with a phone charger and all lights (note if bulbs are missing). If the electricity doesn't work when you check the house, have it written down!

Test all openings (doors and windows) and locks. Check the condition of the floors, walls. and ceilings, noting any defects (marks, cracks, crumbling paint etc.). Test the taps for leaks and the quality of the seals. The inventory of fixtures must include the water, gas, and electricity meter readings. If you notice any defects in the property after the initial inspection, you must report them as soon as possible by registered letter with acknowledgement of receipt, the letter is authentic from the day of sending.



Sharing a flat with French people will allow you to increase your language level and also allows you to know a person who can guide you in Lyon and give you advice.

After finding an apartment, you can benefit from a financial housing aid: this financial aid is offered to all students no matter where they come from and how much their revenue is. Apply to it through their web site or mobile application https://www.caf.fr/.

You have to subscribe to the electricity, water & gas (depending if you have gas or only electricity) in your apartment through EDF, Energie De France mainly state owned. Or other private companies like ENGIE, ENI, TOTAL ENERGIE...https://particulier.edf.fr



There are different packages depending on your energy consumption

VISA PROCEDURE

If you need a residence permit, you must go to the OFII as soon as you arrive, there you will have a medical examination and an interview about your integration.

Also, if you decide to stay longer in Lyon, don't forget to go to the prefecture to renew your visa.

BANK ACCOUNT

If you're an international student, it is really important to have a **French Bank account**. It could be useful for many advantages:

To benefit from the housing aid, to facilitate Bank transfers and payment between friends.

MOBILE PLAN

"The best in the world", France offers one of the best mobile plans in the world by giving unlimited 5G, unlimited calls, unlimited texts for 16€ to 20€ per month. We do recommand FREE mobile, one of the best offers in the market.



FREE is a French operator offering low-cost Internet and telephone packages! It's arguably the best quality-price offer: $2 \in / 13 \in / 20 \in$ (unlimited data, calls & sms)



SFR is another French operator offering attractive packages, notably with its low-cost subsidiary RED. It offers telephone and internet prices : 10€ / 19€



Sosh, a brand of the Orange operator, is a range of low-cost offers developed to reach the young generation by proposing crazy offers around 16€ including 150GB & unlimited calls / sms



Bouygues is one of the four historical companies of telecom. It's renown for an excellent quality of service. B&YOU is a low cost alternative but for the quality you're getting you can't get much lower price than them.

HEALTH & INSURANCE

There are many important insurances to have in France:

Doctor: Doctolib.fr



For a medical appointment you can book a place on "Doctolib.fr" or on their app. You should filter the doctors by location, date, specialty & by their price before choosing one.

Try to choose sector 1 general practitioner, the consultation fee is set by the agreement at 26.5 euros. As the Social Security reimbursement is 70%, you will receive a reimbursement of 16.50 euros. minus the 1 euro fixed contribution.

Benefit from a 70% refund you should have a "medecin traitant" It's your referral doctor in France

How to get a "médecin traitant"? : Book a general appointment with a doctor and ask them to be your referral doctor. You may be refused at some, don't let this unmotivate you keep trying until you have one.













Emergency at the hospital: With the European insurance card, care and treatment are free, but there is a lot of waiting.

If your condition isn't urgent, call this number, a doctor will come to your home to examine you.

TRANSPORTATION

USEFUL APPLICATIONS:



SNCF CONNECT: Official French train company & application to book all your trips with few simple clicks.

E-tickets and travel information are all available on it.



VELOV: Is a network of 5000 bikes that gives you access to 428 stations to ride through the entire Metropole of Lyon. You can subscribe for 16.5€ per YEAR if you're a student.



DOTT: Electric scooter called "trottinette". Slide through the city in a very fast way. Price: It costs 1€ to open the scooter and 0,25€/1min. You can buy different subscriptions...



TCL: The official public transportation app that will guide you through the fastest routes to take in Lyon.

ON SIGHT: You can buy a ticket at the entrance of each station for 2€, valid 1h across the entire transportation network.



CITY MAPPER: For one journey, the application gives you several combinations of transport modes. It also has an alighting alert system and warns you when you need to get off the tram/bus/metro.



CITIZ: You can use self-service electric cars if you have a valid driving license in France.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION







Transport network:

- 4 Lines of metro, including two driverless trains line B & D
- 2 Funiculaire lines. Basically a metro that goes up and down the hill
- 7 Tramway lines
- 129 Bus lines

Card conditions:

You should go to one of the TCL offices to create a TCL card. You should bring a picture or you, a proof of address in Lyon, the 5€ cost of the card, and an identity card.

At night:

- During the week: Start at 5h30 & stop around midnight.
- Friday & Saturday : The lines start at 5h30 and stay until 2am.

The técély card subscription :

Allows unlimited access to the TCL transportation network for 25€/month for students aged between 18-25 years old.



PLEINE LUNE / AT NIGHT

On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, there are 4 buses linking the city center to the main residential areas. One departure per hour between 1 am and 4 am:

- PL1 : Terreaux La Doua via Part-Dieu et Charpennes
- PL2 : Hôtel de Ville Grange Blanche
- PL3 : Hôtel de Ville Campus Lyon Ouest
- PL4 : Hôtel de Ville Saint Priest via Bellecour, Jean Macé, Debourg et Parilly

TRANSPORTATION IN FRANCE

INTERNATIONAL BUSES

The main bus companies in France are FlixBus, Blablacar and Eurolines. Most of them arrive at the railway stations, which are very well served by Lyon's public transport system. All of them have their proper App & Website.





ALL TRAINS

The national train company is the SNCF. You can use Ouigo, Trainline, La Renfe & Train-italia for cheaper options.





Stations:

Mainline trains arrive at **Lyon Part-Dieu** station and eventually at **Lyon Perrache**. Both stations are located within the city and are well served by tram, bus and underground.

Please note that some trains arrive at the TGV station at Saint Exupéry airport: Avoid this station as it is far from the city and has poor transport links.

There are 3 types of trains:

- TGV : The fastest (Paris- Lyon in only 2 hours). Reservations are mandatory. (300Km/h trains)
- Intercités : Classic trains, less fast. It is recommended to make a reservation
- TER (regional express trains): Trains or buses linking towns in the same region. No reservation required, fixed price depending on the period.

SAINT EXUPERY AIRPORT


Lyon-Saint Exupéry Airport (LYS) is located 30km east of the city, Public transport in Lyon does not connect to this airport except Bus IE and 47.


The Rhônexpress tramway links the airport to Lyon Part-Dieu station in 30 minutes for approximately 15€. You can take this special train from Gare Part Dieu La villette.


Time tables: A train comes every 30mins

HELPFUL FRENCH TERMS

Terms	Explanation
Bail	This is the contract between you and the owner (or agency) of the flat. It specifies the rent, the surface area of the flat.
Caution	The amount of money you must pay when you sign the lease. It will be returned to you within two months of the end of the lease.
État des lieux	This is the inventory of the state of the flat, it is carried out on entry and exit.
Charges	The charges correspond to the maintenance of the building, rubbish taxes, etc They can sometimes include electricity, water (cold or hot) and/or heating.
Assurance habitation	You must take out home insurance as soon as you have found your accommodation. Estate agents may refuse to give you the keys if you do not provide proof of this, the two student health insurance companies (SMERRA) offer some of the cheapest insurance policies. You can also find banks that offer services.
Aide personnalisée au logement	All students are eligible for this monthly financial aid (except in eligible cases of subletting) You can apply for APL, also known as CAF, after signing your lease. To do this you must fil in the forms and send your completed file. This monthly assistance will be paid into a French bank account (French is mandatory).
Studio	A large living room (bedroom/lounge) with a kitchenette + bathroom and toilet
T1 or F1	A kitchen separated from the main room (bedroom and living room) + bathroom and toilet
T1 bis or F1 bis	A living room with an open kitchen area + bedroom + bathroom and toilet.
T2/T3/T4	The number represents the number of rooms in the flat + kitchen + bathroom and toilet.
CDI	Contrat à Durée Indéterminée, with no foreseen end.
CDD	Contrat à Durée Déterminée, The fixed terms.
INTERIM / EXTRA	Temporary jobs, on a determined time. It can be few hours or few days.
